Chinese Language Program

Chinese language courses are taught by experienced language teachers.

The elementary level courses include reading, speaking and listening. The medium level and above include writing, Chinese culture, etc.

Chinese language program provides classes in five levels: A(Beginner level), B(Elementary level), C(Intermediate level 1), D(Intermediate level 2), E(Advanced level). Level B-E students will be put into different levels according to the result of the placement test. The fall program includes 18 teaching weeks and 20 sessions per week. Timetable will be issued one week before the start of the new semester.

The above program will provide offline courses. Class may be canceled if not enough students are enrolled. Courses and activities are subject to change if necessary.

Placement Test Date: September 11, 2026

Costs

Tuition: RMB 9000 per semester, RMB 18000 per year.

Registration fee: RMB 400 (for new student)

Insurance fee: RMB 400 per semester, RMB 800 per year.

Application process

Application qualification

- 1.Be in good health, at least 18 years old and under 50 years old in general.
- 2.Hold a high school diploma or equivalent academic qualification.
- 3.Possess a valid foreign passport with a validity period of no less than 6 months starting from the enrollment date and covering the entire semester. Please do not alter personal



information after submission; otherwise, the visa re-application process will be lengthy and may affect enrollment arrangements.

Admission

The admission result will be released within 20 working days after the application materials are submitted to the application system for international students. The academy may provide relevant documents for students whose visa application for student visa or residence permit (study) is approved. Materials may be delayed to varying degrees due to system audits.

Registration

Students shall go to the International Student Office to register on the scheduled registration date and pay all the due fees. Any delay of registration must be approved by the International Student Office beforehand.

Visa

STA will issue documents for students to apply for Student Visa or Residence Permit (study). Students who will study in China for more than 6 months should hold a passport and student visa (X1 visa). Students who will study in China for less than 6 months should hold a passport and student visa (X2 visa).

Insurance

According to the regulations of Ministry of Education of China, international students should purchase mandatory Foreign Student Overall Insurance during their stay in China. The insurance fee is RMB 800 per year, RMB 400 for four to six months. The insurance will be paid by the students and processed by the International Student Office.
